## Can I study for Chartered Banker?

**Yes**, provided you hold one of the following qualifications, or have relevant work experience:-

- Certificate/Diploma in Financial Services/CIOBS be-spoke qualification
- Advanced Diploma in Financial Services
- A regulatory qualification such as MAPC or CIP
- A degree from a recognised University
- An HNC/HND or equivalent
- Other Professional Qualifications may also be considered

## Will you provide me with any learning support?

## How will I be assessed?

Students must successfully complete the specified assignments and a written examination for each subject. All examinations are taken in strict examination conditions and from 2009 the examinations will be offered in UK recognised on-line examination centres.

## Are there any exemptions?

**Yes.** All graduates from a recognised university will be granted 3 non-specific subject exemptions regardless of their degree subject matter. In addition candidates can apply for one further subject exemption based on their degree from Section B. There is a fee for exemptions.

## What is the cost?

- Single credit subject costs £600
- Half credit subject costs £350
- Student subscription £52

The subject cost includes: the full learning package, an examination fee, plus one exam re-sit should you fail on your first attempt and a revision course.

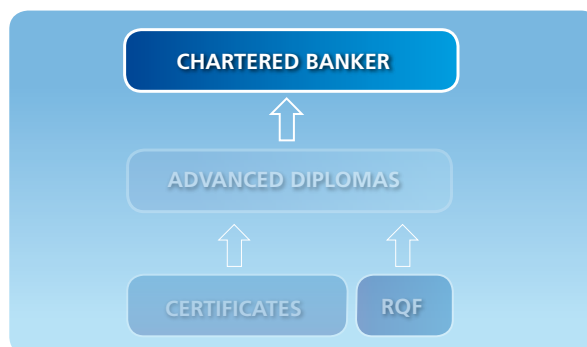
