Revision Course Update – September 2008



As you know, future examinations for all qualifications based on Chartered Banker subjects will be taken on-line.

This innovative and ground-breaking move commenced in the early part of the summer and, to date, 20 subjects are now available on-line. This gives you unprecedented control over your own study plans and almost total flexibility as you progress through your chosen qualification.

With the demise of the fixed examination diets and the introduction of on-demand, on-line examinations, revision support has also been revamped. As previously intimated, face-to-face courses will continue to be offered in the short term, with the first courses for the **core subjects** running from 14th October through to 11th November 2008.

Further opportunities for face-to-face revision for the core subjects will also be available in the periods **April – June** and **September – November 2009** (actual dates to be confirmed).

For all Chartered Banker **elective subjects**, a rolling programme of face-to-face Revision Courses has been scheduled for the period **January – March 2009**.

We will however be introducing e-learning revision modules as a more flexible alternative to face-to-face revision. These will be available free of charge and on-demand via our website. As and when these become available, they will replace the traditional courses.



In order that you can effectively plan your study schedule, we attach the programme of Revision Courses for 2008 and 2009.

Applications to attend a revision course should be made via the CIOBS website or may be advised via email on gillian@ciobs.org.uk. Please also note that in order to secure a guaranteed place, applications **must** be made to CIOBS **at least 2 weeks** in advance of the course date.
